

Codemasters fly on to the ST market with a full price, action packed arcade shoot'em-up. And there's no egg in sight!

Although Codemasters have made a name for themselves with their famous egg character - *Dizzy* - they are now improving that reputation by releasing

some quality full price games onto the market. The latest in this flurry of games is *Fire Hawk* - a multi-directional, scrolling arcade shoot'em-up.

Bedtime story

I know a storyline in a game like this isn't really necessary but I'll give you a brief outline so you don't think you're risking your life for nothing! The small Republic of Lafia have been invaded by Drug Barons who have decided to set up their main operation in this small country. The current Government is helpless against them so they

request aid from America to help rid their country of these nefarious activities.

The White House agrees and sends in a crack group of Green Beret paratroopers who have been dropped in to recon the area and then return with vital information. Your job as pilot of the *Fire Hawk* rescue helicopter is to recover them and return them back to the safety of their ship.

Each mission will start and finish on your deployment

ship. You begin the game with three lives and a full quota of ammo and energy. You will be awarded an extra life when you reach 100,000 points.

As you take off from the ship, a small circular sight will be positioned in front of you with an arrow inside. This arrow will point to the nearest paratrooper who can then be rescued and taken back to the ship. You can carry up to four paras at one time and you will be given extra ammo, fuel and

shields for every one you return.

The circular sight is also used to indicate your target for dropping bombs. They can be dropped by pressing fire and pulling back on your joystick. When you have rescued

all the paras from the current level, your circular sight will change into a square one and the arrow will now refer to the position of your ship.

Your firepower can be increased in speed and numbers by collecting the various

icons that appear when you destroy a certain building or enemy vessel. They have different uses but they can range from three way fire to extra shields and weapons.

The para rescue section is pretty smart. When you find one of the paras, you hover over him and you will then go into the rescue section. This is very similar to the classic hyper sports clay pigeon shooting section.

Your ship is hovering head on and your gunsights are positioned on the left and right. After lowering your rope, you must then catch the enemy helicopters in your sights and shoot them before they inflict damage on your ship. After a while, the para will climb up the rope and be safely on board your hovering gunship. Jason



must collect if you are to succeed.

The most important of these objects are the Puzzle Cards. Each stage contains at least one Puzzle Card and the level master (a McDonaldland character) will request at least four of these before showing you the way to the next level.

Full house

So if you need four cards to get off level one, you will have to complete at least four stages and collect four of the available cards.

A map screen will be displayed every time you are choosing a new stage. Using the joystick, you must direct Mick or Mack along the path to your chosen stage. If a level has not been completed, you will not be allowed to go past it.

You can still return to an already completed level whenever you want.

The original idea came from Lucasfilm Games which generally ensures a top pedigree. True enough a lot of time and effort has been put into this game but at the end of the day it's complex to get into and certainly won't appeal to every type of gamer.

What you've basically got here is a simulation of an entire conflict where you control not only the ships involved in the battle but helicopters and missile bases too.

Master plan

The art behind the game is to configure a task force yourself. The decisions you make at this point will affect your success throughout the entire game. Any of the craft you have under your control can be controlled by you at any one time. This enables you to fine tune your battle plan to your heart's content.

The game is entirely mouse controlled and can even be played

on a 520STE. There are no 1 meg restrictions for most of you. Graphically the game is impressive but only for a war game! There's nothing startling on either the visual or sonic front by today's standards mind, so don't expect anything mind-blowing to greet you when you load it up!

At the end of the day it's a mas-


Big boxes, big titles, low prices. Hit Squad have done it again with a little help from their new found friends at Electronic Arts...

ACTION REVIEW

There's only really one company that deals with the needs of serious wargamers. London's Impressions have steadily been building up a reputation over the past couple of years for producing high quality wargames.

It's a difficult market to aim for as it is a relatively small niche in the overall gamesplaying world, but these guys know what they are going for and do their job well. Cohort II, perhaps not surprisingly, is the follow-up to last year's Cohort.

Since it is part of Impressions' Micro Miniature range experienced wargamers should already be fully aware of what they're in for. The game looks similar to many of their other previous wargames, but the advantage of this is that they can appeal to a lot of people who wouldn't normally look at this stuff as they are quite pretty to behold!

there as Cohort but this sequel has a novel feature in that it can be linked up with Impressions' other game - Caesar, which is certainly one of the best titles they have yet produced. A special disk comes in the package that you must run before linking them for the first time. Once all the formalities of running this disk have been done away with it's on to the game proper.

Hail Caesar

What this link-up allows you to do really is enhance Caesar as opposed to Cohort II. Where battles would previously just be fought out beyond your control, now Cohort II loads up and you get to control the battle yourself knowing that the out-

come will alter your city's standing.

Without Caesar though, Cohort II becomes a regular wargame where you must control your legions around various maps as you try to build up an invincible Roman fighting unit.

Moving your troops all over the show is what it's all about and any enemy forces you come across must be obliterated. The game is fairly easy to pick up, but it certainly helps if you're used to this kind of thing. If you've never played a wargame before then Impressions' games are a fine place to start. Whether this is sufficiently different from the others is the big question. If you're a fan you'll like it, if not, at least think twice. Paul



AIR SUPPORT

Psygnosis haven't been pumping out as much stuff as they used to but now they're back in business...

Any game that's described as "revolutionary" is more often than not asking for trouble. Air Support is one such game. Psygnosis have always had a reputation for being clever and persuading the public to play games they ordinarily wouldn't touch.

If that all sounds a bit too controversial most people would have to admit to being taken aback by the polished and professional packaging and presentation from one of this country's leading software publishers. So much so

that you could certainly buy one of their more "average" games on the strength of what you pick up.

Generally that's not a problem because their gear is all of a high quality (take Lemmings 2 for example). Occasionally though they let "more regular" stuff creep out.

In the air

Upon prising open your Air Support box you'll find the usual smart manual and the slightly odder inclusion of a pair of 3D Specs.

I must say it all sounds very impressive. You take your post at the West Point Military Academy as one of your country's leading pilots. You're there to get a job as a top notch defence advisor. This training is to see if you're good enough for the position. You will be using the latest in simulation soft-

ware and you'll have to be good to pass your exams (no GCSE re-sits here!).

You basically have to manage a full defence network and repel attack after attack. To do this you have a number of factories all capable of manufacturing certain vehicles which you can then position and drive around the map generally performing one heroic task after another.

This section of the game is played out in glorious wire-frame, or if you so choose glorious wire-frame 3D



units with which to defend it. It's very unlikely that you'll be attacked by another civilization at this early stage but there is a very real chance of a barbarian raid, especially if your city is near the sea. Barbarian raiding parties tend to

come from the more desolate, polar regions of the map. A strategy to beat the nuisance later on in the game is to spread out as far as possible and try to get an outpost on these bleak, generally uninhabited continents. Raiding

parties tend to die out if the area is civilized.

Once you've got military in position and fortified within your capital, assess the situation. If you believe you are under threat from another ruler, it's probably wise to opt for City Walls as your next project. If you don't perceive any threat then it would be wise to go ahead with the Granary (which is probably what your advisor is suggesting any way!). This food storing structure will allow your city to expand far more rapidly, in turn bringing in more income and speeding the game's processes up.

IN THE ARMY NOW

Once this city is well and truly under way it's time to get some more settlers going. While this unit is under development, send out one of your militia to do a little scouting and hunt around for a potential new city site. Look for key things like good terrain close to resources, be it animals or minerals.

Either way, water nearby should be one of the most important features of the site finally chosen.

SETTLE DOWN

By now, your settlers should be nearly ready. Once they are completed send them out and head for your second city site. Along the way build roads (press R). It may take a number of turns before you can move them again, but it's far better in the long run. The number of turns it takes a settler unit to build a road section (or anything else for that matter) is entirely dependant on the terrain. While you are creating a link to your new city, you should build at least one more militia unit to cover for the one you have out there exploring.

SUPERCONDUCTOR

Civilization Advance

When electric current is passed through a conductor, such as a copper wire, a small but significant amount of the current is lost to resistance. When certain substances are cooled to temperatures near absolute zero, this resistance disappears. This phenomenon is called superconductivity, and a substance with no electrical resistance is a **SUPERCONDUCTOR**. THE HISTORY OF MANGA

AND THE BEGINNING OF A NEW ERA IN ANIMATION AS WE KNOW IT ...

There may have been an occasion recently where you found yourself in your local game's shop. It's also highly possible that during this visit you may have noticed a shelf containing items other than games. It's equally possible that these said items were Japanese animation videos.

An awful lot of computer stores have recently started stocking a range of animation vids because they see the obvious link between games and the movies themselves. Japanese style characters have been used in games for several years now. Games like Pang and Rodland both featured the big-eyed, ever-so-cute kids featured so heavily in Japan in virtually any kind of literature that they produce en masse.

Odd slant

Comics (or manga as they are known over there) are part of a way of life for the whole Japanese culture. Absolutely everybody reads 'em and there are thousands to choose from. It is perhaps a natural progression therefore to animate the most popular characters and turn them into full length action films. That's what's been happening for years and years in Japan but it has only really been in the last year that we've started to see such films become freely available to buy or rent in this country.

Anime (pronounced Ah-nee-may so now you can impress your mates with your first word of Japanese!) is the buzz word for Jap animation. It is the word used to distinguish such work from European or American animations and it is big business in the Far East. The Japanese have always had a tendency to completely exaggerate a character's physique and abilities (a recent example would be the many magical moves in a game like Street Fighter II). For an interesting reason behind why their films are always so aggressive and often

depict scenes of nuclear devastation you can go back to World War II and the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Put the two together and you have films of a potentially volatile nature waiting to explode in a barrage of action and violence.

Never afraid to feature things that many in the West would consider perverse and sometimes far too explicit for normal viewing, Anime will quite often depict scenes of rape and sex, generally with some sort of nasty mutant character! It's also noticeable that there tends to

be a large number of schoolgirls bending over just to show off their underwear! Chances are you'll be shocked the first time you see one, but in response to the potential argument that these videos will breed violence and abuse you only have to look at Japan's violent crime rates which are among the lowest in the world.

Turning Japanese



Younger children could occasionally get lost in the plot which as you may have gathered by this point, can get rather tricky on occasion even for the adult who pays all the attention in the

A company called Island World Communications are the company responsible for distributing anime films in this country. They now have a division called Manga Video who deal specifically with Japanese cartoon movies. Their distribution and stocking in computer shops is a major coup as it brings the titles to the front and to people's attention. It's all big business in this country now. T-Shirts, caps, comics and a load of other stuff are freely available as long as you know a good stockist. Comic shops are a good bet, although we've seen gear in Virgin in Manchester. So where ever you go Manga is definitely in your face.




Obviously getting her back is of prime importance, but saving the world is also up there on his priority list.

TETSUO THE IRON MAN

A word of warning – don't ever use a stainless steel Japanese shaver. That's what our lead character, Tetsuo does and he ends up mutating into a fusion of metal and flesh after cutting his chin. Although this film isn't actually a Manga release (or a 'cartoon' for that matter) it features complicated film animation and special effects that could easily embarrass a young film maker from Screen Test.

It is based in a futuristic Japan where technology and machines are taking over and Tetsuo begins to have nightmares

involving metal monsters with more wires and attachments than a Black & Decker. He is horrified to find that he too is turning into a cyborg, and things become a real pain in the circuits when his wife wants to know why he's hiding in the bathroom. Being a machine does have it's advantages however as he can zoom round town at high speed

thanks to his rockets which sprouted from his heels.

We later discover the nightmares were a result of guilt after he accidentally runs over a man who then seeks revenge. He does this by possessing the body of Tetsuo's wife and launches a bitter and hostile attack. Both characters have special powers from their partly mechanical



physiques and it all ends in a chaotic battle with plenty of blood, guts and wires.

This is a real 'behind the sofa' type of video so if you're familiar with films like Eraserhead by David Lynch or Hell-raiser by Cronenberg then

this could be just what you've been waiting for.

Of all the videos featured this was certainly my favourite, but wouldn't suit everybody as it's broad-minded arthouse themes may cause offence to the squeamish. Tetsuo 2 is scheduled for the cinema in the not too distant future – so don't say you weren't warned. Miss this at your own peril!

There's a lot of blood in this one, but nothing overly gory!



Akira was the first Manga Video film to become popular in this country. It was the film that stood out in the video shops as being something different but was also the one that a lot of people weren't prepared to try because it was so far away from the norm.

This has been described as the greatest film ever by a lot of critics. It really is hard to see how it could be any better. The computer assisted animation techniques used within this film are the greatest ever used. The characters all move so perfectly it really has to be seen to be believed. This is cartoon technology at it's very, very best.

It probably won't be bettered. Set in Tokyo thirty years from now, it's another one of those

films that features a strong nuclear background. The Third World War has long gone leaving Neo-Tokyo in it's wake. As you might expect in a landscape as hostile as this the place is filled with all sorts of nasty people all wanting to run their share of the show. Expect a barrage of Cyber-punks and rock a loud rock music soundtrack to accompany them! The two main characters Tetsuo (not to be confused with the Tetsuo who has a bit of metallic problem reviewed elsewhere) and Kaneda soon get entwined in a terrific but yet again complicated story involving the military and the secret of Akira!

Stunning stuff also available in a collector's double pack with the original English subtitled version (these days it has full English dialogue) and a second cassette show-

ing The Making of Akira. We actually had a bit of a problem finding anything other than this twin pack but Akira marketing is really beginning to take off now. T-Shirts featuring both the characters and the logos are freely available on clothing along with a whole range of Manga gear that can now be obtained.



Batman was one of the most successful films of all time. Grossing millions in the first weekend, it went straight into the number one spot of virtually every chart available. It commanded huge audiences across the country and increased the profiles of the actors involved (Danny DeVito, Michelle Pfeifer and Michael Keaton) by ten fold.

Always one to latch on to a good thing, Konami have snapped up the rights for what must be one of the most long awaited computer transitions in the history of computer entertainment.

Bat-lastic

Under development by Liverpool based Denton Designs, Batman Returns is surely set to shoot straight into the number one spot of the all formats charts. The game is loosely based around the film and is set over five levels of intense arcade action.

Level one begins over the horizontally scrolling background of the

impressive Gotham Plaza at Christmas time. The Mayor, Shreck and the Ice Princess are all standing on an elevated platform when the screen scrolls left and a giant gift box appears.

The crowd cheer as the Xmas present comes to rest but then scream in terror as it explodes and baddies burst out from all sides. Suddenly, the Batlight appears in the sky and the Batmobile screeches onto the screen. Climbing into the rubber suit of Batman, you must battle with the evil minions of the Red Triangle Gang to eventually rescue the beautiful Selina Kyle.

The level culminates as Batman encounters Selina being held captive by a vicious clown. As he makes his way towards the girl, he will be attacked by various baddies and they will continue to make it difficult for him to reach the grapple gun that is lying nearby. When he has finally nailed the bad guys and picked up the gun, he must then shoot the gun at the clown, missing him but pulling a section of the background onto the clown and saving the girl.

Colour-blind Dairylea

Level two is again set in the Plaza but this time it is a scene of dereliction and an obvious setting for crime and wrong doings. The screen scrolls to rest on the still, contemplative figure of Batman. He must battle against the Red Triangle Gang again but this time they have help from The Penguin who will float around on his heli-umbrella, dropping bombs on Batman. After a short while, he will encounter a clown who must be defeated in order for batman to collect a bomb that must be used on the end of the level. The "end of level guardian" is the Strongman. This chap is virtually impossible to defeat unless you have the bomb from earlier in the level. Throwing the bomb at him will cause him to fall down a manhole and explode.

The third level of the five sees the introduction of the beautiful Catwoman and also describes how she has destroyed Shreck's department store. In a




one to one battle across the rooftops, Batman must jump and somersault from platform to platform, pushing Catwoman off and forcing her to the far left hand side of the screen. She will always land on her feet until you get her to the end of the level where she will eventually be pushed over the building and into a passing sandtruck.

Strangeways!

After a pretty short third level, Batman must once again take to the rooftops in the fourth level. This time he must deal with hordes of bats and vicious minions as well as the Penguin who also makes an appearance but he will back off after a few successful hits. The local police force will also try to kill Batman as they think he is the one who has kidnapped the Ice Princess. Unfortunately, he cannot kill the police so he must use his acrobatic skills to good effect and avoid them.

As he reaches the end of the section, he will once again do battle with the voluptuous Catwoman. This time she will be even more determined to kill him. No matter how well he performs, he will be forced off the edge of

the roof. Fortunately, there is a batwings token on this part and Catwoman will do her best to stop him reaching it. If he manages to collect it, he will glide safely down to the ground.

The final level is split into three different parts. The first section is set on the circus train where Batman must rescue the children. He then enters the sewer system where he is faced with killer robot penguins, and thirdly enter the Arctic World of Penguin's Lair. Here he must battle with Shreck

and Catwoman before finally reaching the last fight with the Penguin himself.


To rescue the children, Batman must defeat the remaining members of the Red Triangle Gang along the top of the carriages of the moving circus train. This is made difficult as the driver continues to accelerate and brake in order to throw Batman off balance. Falling in between the carriages will cause Batman to lose a life. In order to complete this section, Batman must knock out the driver and pull a lever to open the cages. This lever also opens the grate obstructing the entrance to the sewer system.

The first section of the sewer system is a kind of two dimensional maze. Toxic waste will continue

to flow and touching this will cause Batman to lose vital energy. Movement throughout the maze is done by utilising the rusty ladders, broken platforms and overcoming the huge gaps that will appear in the platforms. A Penguin locator can be collected to aid Batman as he searches for the Penguin's Lair.

A purr-fect pavilion

The final stage of the game is set in the Arctic Pavilion. Shreck is tied to a generator and Catwoman is about to deliver the final blow to his already heaving body. Batman must fight her to save his life. If she gets past Batman, she will jump onto Shreck, forcing him into the generator.

Penguin will appear out of the gloom on his yellow duck. He will attack Batman with a host of deadly umbrellas, backed up by his own troops and the rest of the Red Triangle gang. Batman must move from iceberg to iceberg until he can collect a spare penguin bazooka and use it to blast the duck. Penguin will then lose the protection of the duck and will resort to fighting Batman on the icebergs which are breaking up and melting.

After finally destroying the penguin, the screen moves up to the sky where you can see the lights in the tower building shining bright along with the ever present Batsignal. The screen then zooms into the Batsignal, it flashes on, off, and then a quiet miaow can be heard.




game (La Secte Noire!) for the Amstrad 1990. It did the business in France and Lankhor snapped it up and adapted it to the new versions.

I've been searching for a compilation called Double Double Bill for a long time and recently found an advert (in another mag) for one of those distribution houses showing that they had this product.


